Criteria:

- Bursary to be given out at the Commencement Ceremonies at the Osoyoos Secondary School and following the guidelines of the school's bursary process;
- Applicant must be an active member of the Sun Bowl Skating Club, as described in our constitution, for five years prior to graduation;
- Applicants must submit an application letter;
- Applicants must have a C+ average or better in all grade 11 and 12 subjects to be eligible to apply;
- Applicant must use the bursary for post secondary education within 18 months of graduation (must provide proof of payment to claim funds);
- If an Applicant is not an active member of the Club due to a medical reason a partial member; as described in our constitution is accepted. The applicant will also have to volunteer 20 hours to the Club each year they are not an active member for five years prior to graduation;
- If the Applicant is an active member of the Sun Bowl Skating Club, they must have 30 hours of volunteer time with the Club during the five years prior to graduation;
- The Board and Head Coach of the Sun Bowl Skating Club will decide on the recipient of the bursary;
- For our American members they can also apply with all the same criteria required.
